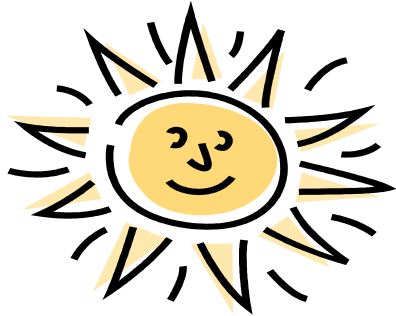


St. Peter's School

The summer program, conveniently located in Society Hill, offers small age appropriate groups, experienced faculty, and a chance to learn, create, and of course, have fun!

The St. Peter's School Summer Program is for children entering Preschool through Grade One. The Summer Program lasts 6 weeks, beginning in June and continuing through July. Families may register for as many weeks as they would like. Children can attend the Half-day Sessions (8:30 a.m.-12 p.m.) or Full Day Sessions (8:30 a.m.-4 p.m.)

Young children (must be toilet-trained) participate in a balanced morning program of structured play and learning. The day is full of age appropriate activities including circle time, music, arts and crafts, French lessons, active games, and plenty of time outside!

The children are in small groups of no more than 12 campers with a lead teacher and an assistant. All of our teachers are experienced educators. Visiting puppet shows, animal enthusiasts, and singers supplement the program each week. We hope your child can join us this summer!
